Fearing for her mental health and for her safety, the residents and local police suggest she be sectioned. Left alone in a hospital room, the force controlling Josie is finally revealed.

INT. PRIVATE HOSPITAL ROOM - AFTERNOON

JOSIE is sat at a dressing table, staring at herself in the mirror with a sense of melancholy. She does a double take and the figure of ANGIE appears in the mirror, over JOSIE'S shoulder. The ensuing conversation is seen entirely in the mirror.

JOSIE

What makes you think you can get away with this? Someone's going to see you.

ANGIE

(calmly, and in control)
Don't be so crass Josie. You and I both know that isn't going to happen.

JOSIE

I bought you back here, what more do you want from me?

ANGIE

I've already made my position very clear to you.

JOSIE

All you've done for months now is confuse me.

ANGIE

I don't think you realise how much you need me Josie. You always have.

JOSIE

I stopped needing you a long time ago.

ANGIE

I wouldn't be here if that were the case.

JOSIE

What could I possibly need you for now?

ANGIE

(beat)
Dylan.

JOSIE

(shaken)
That's all in the past now, and
it's where it's staying. You moved
on and I moved on.

ANGIE

You can never move on from anything
that concerns me. Look.

ANGIE leans over JOSIE'S shoulder, so their heads are
directly next to each other.

ANGIE (CONT'D)

You're an extension of me.
Everytime you look in the mirror
I'm staring back at you. You are
me.

JOSIE

(low tone, slowly)
I am nothing like you.

ANGIE

(firmly, gesturing toward
the mirror)
Look. Really look. I am always with
you Josie, and I always will be.
There might be times when
(beat)
Inconviniences prevent these
conversations, but the sooner you
realise that I am always a part of
you, the better it'll be for you in
the long run.
(beat)
And better for Dylan.

JOSIE

A part of me or not, he'll have to
know one day.

ANGIE

He's survived 23 years without
knowing and I'm not going to let
you ruin that. I've always
protected him and I'm never going
to stop.

There is a knock at the door. ANGIE turns to look at it.

DOCTOR

(from outside the door)
Josie?

ANGIE turns back to the mirror.

ANGIE
I should go.

JOSIE
What's stopping you this time?

ANGIE takes out a stick of lipstick from her pocket and looks in the mirror as she reapplies it.

ANGIE
I make it a rule never to leave
before I'm ready.

The door opens and the DOCTOR enters. JOSIE spins round, to look at ANGIE, expectant of a reaction from the Doctor - but she has disappeared.
